**Admission to M.Sc. Medical Physics (Two Year) Programme (2026 – 2028)
Entrance Examination Notification**

The entrance examination for admission to the two-year M.Sc. Medical Physics Programme (2026–2028), offered by the Department of Medical Physics, Bharathidasan University, is scheduled for Friday, June 12, 2026, at 10:00 AM in the Department of Medical Physics, Bharathidasan University, Palkalaiperur (Main) Campus, Tiruchirappalli. The examination will last 90 minutes and consist of 50 objective-type questions based on the B.Sc. Physics syllabus of Bharathidasan University, including allied Mathematics.

Candidates are prohibited from bringing calculators, mobile phones, smartwatches, or any other electronic devices to the examination hall. Candidates must bring their own pen, pencil, and eraser.

Candidates who have not uploaded the required documents with their online application must submit self-attested copies of the following at the time of the entrance examination:

- SSLC/HSC mark sheet or equivalent proof of date of birth
- Community certificate (if applicable),
- B.Sc. Physics mark/grade sheets (all semesters/years),
- Application fee payment receipt.

Additionally, candidates must provide a separate self-attested sheet listing Part III marks (Theory and Practical) for verification during the examination.

Candidates must bring their admit card (downloaded from the admission portal) along with a valid photo ID, such as a college ID, Aadhaar card, voter ID, driving license, or any other government-issued photo identification, to the examination hall.

The Palkalaiperur (Main) Campus is located approximately 16 km from the Central Bus Stand and Railway Junction in Tiruchirappalli, along the Tiruchirappalli - Pudukkottai Highway.

M.SC. MEDICAL PHYSICS PROGRAMME (2026-2028)

ADMISSION PROCEDURE

Candidates will be selected for admission to the M.Sc. (Medical Physics) programme based on a rank list prepared by allocating 50 marks to the entrance examination and 50 marks to the Part-III examination of the B.Sc. Physics (undergraduate) degree. The final rank list and the list of provisionally selected candidates will be announced at 3:00 PM on June 12, 2026.

Provisionally selected candidates will be admitted immediately and must pay the admission fees, as specified, through online payment only via the application portal on the same day, June 12, 2026, before 5:00 PM.

If a selected candidate is unable to join on June 12, 2026, their admission will be cancelled, and a candidate from the waiting list will be admitted immediately in their place.

At the time of admission, selected candidates must submit the following original certificates to the Department of Medical Physics office for verification:

- SSLC or HSC mark sheet or date of birth certificate
- Community certificate (if applicable)
- Consolidated mark sheet (if available)
- Transfer certificate from the institution last attended (if available)

- *Tuition Fee – 100% exemption at the time of admission for SC/ST and Converted Christian students, as per G.O. Ms. No. 722 dated 13.10.1977 of the Tamil Nadu Social Welfare Department, on production of a valid e-Community Certificate. Students must upload and obtain a UMIS number. The tuition fee amount exempted at the time of admission will be*

credited to the student's bank account under the Direct Benefit Transfer (DBT) Scheme. Upon receipt of the DBT amount, students shall remit the tuition fee to the Department without fail
