The University secured ‘A⁺’ grade with 3.32 CGPA on a four-point scale in the 3rd Cycle of Assessment and Accreditation from the NAAC, valid upto 31st March 2024. The University holds 57th Rank in National Institutional Ranking Framework (NIRF) Ranking in 2022 at National level and 5th Rank among the Universities in Tamil Nadu. CENTRE FOR DISTANCE AND ONLINE EDUCATION – A PROFILE

The Centre for Distance and Online Education (CDOE) of Bharathidasan University (BDU) was established in the year 1992 to serve the students who could not enter the regular colleges for higher education. As the educational Programs offered and the degrees awarded through distance mode are qualitatively good and there is a demand for the Programs offered by the CDOE of Bharathidasan University.

- The Centre for Distance and Online Education offers 39 Programs including 20 Undergraduate, 19 Postgraduate Programs.
- Besides the conventional courses, the Centre for Distance and Online Education is offering Programs in Computer Science and Applications, Information Technology, Bank Management, Financial Management, Library and Information Science, etc. The laboratory oriented Programs are meticulously planned and executed with the same vigor as regular Programs, without compromising the practical requirements.
- The Centre for Distance and Online Education conducts theory and practical classes on Saturdays and Sundays. The conduct of the Programs is strictly monitored by the staff of the Centre for Distance and Online Education and the Director through regular visits to the Personal Contact Program (PCP) centres and LSC's.
- The Distance Education Programs are administered through University PCP Centres and Learner Support Centres.

Special Features

Bharathidasan University has been very successful in imparting quality education through distance mode because of strict adherence to the following;

- The policy of Higher Education of the Central and State Governments is followed so as to make higher education affordable to all
- Keeping the quality of curriculum, syllabi and assessment like examination system same for the students studying under regular and distance mode of education
- Bridging the gap between unreachable learners.
- Providing an appropriate learning environment and a good two-way communication between students and teachers
- Deployment of qualified and experienced faculty members for teaching instills confidence among the distance education learners
- Online payment, submission of examination form and issuing of online hall ticket are facilitated for the benefits of the students.
- Granting scholarship to the unemployed SC/ST students who are studying in PCP Centre of CDOE of Bharathidasan University.

KEY POINTS

1. Application forms for admission should be submitted through any one of the following modes:
 1. Conventional mode : By procuring the printed application forms directly from PCP Centres
 2. Online download : By downloading application forms from the website and submission of filled-in application directly or by post
 3. Online submission : By filling-up application form online and sending a printed copy of the same along with supporting documents by post
2. List of Programs offered at LSC and PCP Centres, specimen letters for Change of Address, Change of PCP Centre, Change of Medium and grievances are given in the website.
3. All communications will be sent through email only. Hence, candidates should mention their email IDs in the Application without fail.
4. Important notifications regarding time-table for LSC / PCP classes, time-table for Examinations, Last date for payment of Tuition Fee and Examination Fee will be displayed in the website. Website updates will be intimated through SMS.
5. Study materials will be provided on payment of tuition fees within the stipulated time. Study materials are also available in electronic mode (ebooks) through the University web portal.
6. Examination application forms should be submitted through online mode only. Notification regarding examinations will be displayed in the website - www.bdu.ac.in/cde
7. First year candidates should register for all first year papers for the Examinations without fail.
8. Candidates who are eligible to get Scholarship should apply immediately after being admitted into their respective degree Programs .
9. Candidates are advised to mention the Unique number in all communications and also bring their ID card while coming to the University for any purpose.

PROCEDURES FOR ADMISSION

ADMISSION PROCEDURE

- Candidates may avail spot admission at the office of the Centre for Distance and Online Education during all working days and at all the PCP Centres and Learner Support Centres during Saturdays and Sundays.
- The CDOE offers Postal Admission Facility also for those who are unable to come in person to the office for admission.

MODE OF PAYMENT

- All the fee payments to the University towards Registration, Admission, Tuition, Change of PCP Centre, Change of Address, Change of Medium, etc., are to be made **through online payment at the State Bank of India online portal (www.bdu.ac.in/online-payment)**. In case of Demand Drafts, it should be drawn in favour of 'Bharathidasan University' payable at Tiruchirappalli.
- Examination fee should be remitted **through online payment at the State Bank of India online portal (www.bdu.ac.in/online-payment)**. In case of Demand Drafts, it should be drawn in favour of 'Bharathidasan University' payable at Tiruchirappalli.
- Fee once paid will not be adjusted with any other account.

1	For discontinuing the course within 30 calendar days from the date of admission and without attending PCP Classes.	50% of the Tuition fees alone be refunded.
2	For discontinuing the course thereafter, with or without attending any PCP Classes.	No refund.
3	For not running a centre for not offering a course / at one or more centres.	The entire fee including registration fee be refunded.

- No extension of time for the payment of fee will be allowed.
- Separate reminder intimation will not be sent.
- Tuition fee can also be paid through **Challan** in the State Bank of India, Bharathidasan University branch, Tiruchirappalli - 24. Challan can be had from the CDOE office.
- The candidates should pay their tuition fee and other fee for second and third years, **on the dates specified in the prospectus**. If the tuition fee is not paid on the specified date, the candidates can pay the fee along with a **penalty of Rs.400/-** in a month's time. **If the candidate fails to pay the tuition fee even after a month, the course will be treated as break of studies.** Re-admission to the course is then subject to the approval of the Authorities of the University.
- For any online payment, payment receipt should be enclosed with the duly-filled-in remittance slip. The remittance slip is available in the website (www.bdu.ac.in/cde)
- The students are advised to retain with them a **photocopy** of each of the **Online Payment Receipt** sent to the CDOE.

GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS

- The method of instruction is through 1) Study Materials and 2) Personal Contact Programs (PCP). Study materials will be supplied to the candidates in the PCP Centres. Every effort is taken to handover the lesson materials of each paper during contact classes. E-books will also be made available in the University website (www.bdu.ac.in/cde)
- Intimation regarding PCP classes, Exam Schedule, Last date for tuition fee and Exam fee will be notified in University website and website updates will be intimated through sms to all candidates.
- In the PCP classes, lectures are delivered on important topics and the doubts of the students are cleared by efficient teachers. These classes will be organized on Saturdays, Sundays and other holidays. If only a few students are registered, the classes and examinations of PCP Centres may be combined. Candidates are advised to attend the PCP classes regularly for effective learning.
- The study materials given by the CDOE are only supporting material. Students are advised to refer to the prescribed Textbooks and reference books for a detailed study.
- The students must fill up their **current mobile number and email ID** in the Admission Application Form without fail for getting notifications through sms or email.
- Application purchased in the name of a candidate cannot be exchanged with others.

IDENTITY CARD

- An **Identity Card** will be provided to each candidate at the time of admission which is valid till the completion of the Program. Students are advised to preserve their identity card safely and **bring it with them without fail to the Examination Centre and also whenever they come to the CDOE Office**. If the Identity card is lost, a duplicate card can be obtained on payment of Rs.200/- through online and a copy of the receipt may be sent to “The Director, Centre for Distance and Online Education, Bharathidasan University, Tiruchirappalli - 620 024” along with a recent stamp size photograph.

UNIQUE NUMBER

- After admission, each candidate will be issued a Unique Number. This number should be quoted in all the communications addressed to the Centre for Distance and Online Education till the completion of their study. The **unique number will also be the Exam Register Number** allotted to the candidate and it will be printed in the first line of the address slip pasted on covers sent to the candidates.

CHANGE OF ADDRESS / PCP CENTRE / MEDIUM OF INSTRUCTION

- If there is any change in the residential address, the candidate should intimate it to the Director, along with a payment of Rs.400/- through online. Students are advised to inform the change of address to the local post-office immediately to receive all communications at their new address as the Centre will take at least a month's time to incorporate the new address in its records. Request for change of address, without the payment of the prescribed fee, will not be entertained.
- Change of PCP centre may be permitted only once during the entire period of the Program and that too on or before the commencement of the Program. The students, who intend to change their PCP centres should send a request letter to the Director along with a payment of Rs.2,000/- through online.
- Students who intend to change the medium of instruction or the course should send a request letter to the Director along with a payment of Rs.1,000/- through online before commencement of the PCP Classes.

BONAFIDE CERTIFICATE / COURSE COMPLETION CERTIFICATE

- Students who wish to obtain Bonafide Certificate should pay Rs.500/- and to obtain Course Completion Certificate should pay Rs.500/- through online mode.

FEE CONCESSIONS

• **Installment of Fees:**

The CDOE students are permitted to remit their fees in two installments. The first installment be remitted at the time of admission and the second installment with Rs.500/- additionally be remitted two months before commencement of the Examinations.

- **Exemption for Differently-abled candidates:**

Differently Abled candidates are given 100% exemption of tuition fees in all Programs offered through the Centre for Distance and Online Education. Candidates who need exemption should produce a copy of the Identity Card issued by the Differently Abled Welfare Department of the Government of Tamil Nadu at the time of admission.

TRANSFER ADMISSION

A student, who needs transfer from a regular college to the CDOE due to his/her personal reasons, should pay the fee as shown below. If a candidate has any arrear paper at the time of studying in the College, he/ she has to get a permission letter from Principal to permit him/her to write the arrear paper in the College in which he/she previously studied. On production of these documents, the candidate may be admitted in the Centre for Distance and Online Education.

EXAMINATION INSTRUCTIONS

- University examination will be conducted at the end of each academic year, on the dates notified by the University. Examinations will be normally held in **April-May** every year. Supplementary examination will also be conducted in **November / December** every year.
- For semester Programs, the examinations will be conducted during the months of November and April of every year.
- The written and the practical examinations for all the Programs will be held **only in the examination centre fixed by the University.**
- The Application Forms for examination will be invited through **Notifications in the University Website.** Candidates are requested to visit the university website during **March** and **September** and apply for the examination before the prescribed date so as to avoid penalty.
- **Registration for Examination:** The candidates have to compulsorily register for Examination for all the papers in the regular / current papers. Fee for the Examination, Revaluation, Marks Statement, Provisional Certificate and Degree Certificate should be paid **through online only.**
- **Exam Application Forms** should be downloaded from the Website, filled-up carefully along fee payment receipt and sent to the Director, Centre for Distance and Online Education, Bharathidasan University, Tiruchirappalli - 620 024, within the last date.
- **TIME TABLE:** The examination time-table will be published in the University Website **www.bdu.ac.in/cde.**
- **HALL TICKETS:** Hall tickets should be downloaded from the University Website three days before the commencement of examinations.

PRACTICAL & PROJECT EVALUATION

- Practical examinations and Project Evaluation will be held only in April/May of each academic year.
- Candidates studying Programs wherein practical subjects are prescribed, must attend atleast 50% of practical classes. Or else they will not be permitted to write the examinations.
- Candidates who fail to appear for practical examinations will have to re-do the practical in the next academic year only by paying Rs.1,500/- for computer lab. Practicals for UG and PG: Rs.3000/- for Science Laboratory practicals and Rs.3000/- for MBA/MCA practicals (to be paid during January/February of each year).
- Candidates who fail to submit Project report should re-do the project work in the next academic year by paying Rs.1500/- for PG/MBA/MCA Programs.

CONSOLIDATED MARKS STATEMENT & PROVISIONAL CERTIFICATE

Candidates, who are in the **final year** of the respective Programs, have to pay a fee of **Rs. 500/- for obtaining Provisional Certificate, Rs.300/- for Two-year Program and Rs.400/- for Three-year Program for obtaining Consolidated Marks Statement and Rs.1000/- for UG Degree and Rs.1500/- for PG Degree for obtaining Degree Certificate** along with the Examination fee. The candidates who have passed all the subjects / papers are qualified for the Degree. Provisional Certificate will be sent to the candidate alongwith the Consolidated Marks Statement.

CONVOCATION

Candidates who have passed all papers and received the Consolidated Marks Statement and Provisional Certificate, should **download the Convocation Form** from the University website, fill it and send it to “The Director, Centre for Distance and Online Education, Bharathidasan University, Tiruchirappalli - 620 024” along with copies of Consolidated Marks Statement and Provisional Certificate and receipt of fee paid through online should be attached with the Convocation Application Form. The Degree Certificate will be sent by Speed Post in about three months after the convocation ceremony, which is held once in a year, usually during the month of November. The candidates can also obtain Degree certificate on the day itself through “**TAKKAL**” system, have to pay a fee of Rs.2000/-. For further details contact Director, Centre for Distance and Online Education, Bharathidasan University.

LEARNER SUPPORT CENTRES

All Programs offered through the CDOE are conducted by Learner Support Centres approved by the University. The list of Learner Support Centres is given in the University website. Some specialized courses are offered through some selected Study Centres only.

GRIEVANCES

If students have any grievances such as non-receipt of Mark Statements etc., they are free to write to the Director, CDOE. Specimen format is given in the University website. Grievance letters may also be handed over to the University representative during PCP classes. Students may also send their grievances through email: cde@bdu.ac.in and cde.exams@bdu.ac.in.

REVISION OF REGULATIONS AND CURRICULUM

The University may from time to time, revise, amend and change the Regulations and the Curriculum as and when necessary.

UNIFORM SPAN PERIOD

- The candidates who got admitted on or after 2018-2019 onwards be allowed to complete the UG/PG Programs within two years from the completion of Program.
- In exceptional circumstances a further extension of one more year may be granted. The exceptional circumstances be spelt out clearly by the relevant statutory body Constituted of the University.
- During the extension period the student shall be considered as a private candidate and also not be eligible for ranking.

BREAK OF STUDY

- A student who has discontinued the Program can be re-admitted only once during the entire Program of study.
- Re-admission fee of Rs.1,500/- for UG/PG and Rs.1500/- for MBA/MCA should be paid along with the tuition fee at the time of admission.
- Re-admitted student shall subscribe to the existing syllabus at the time of re-admission and shall appear for examinations by their own preparation. No separate contact classes will be arranged.

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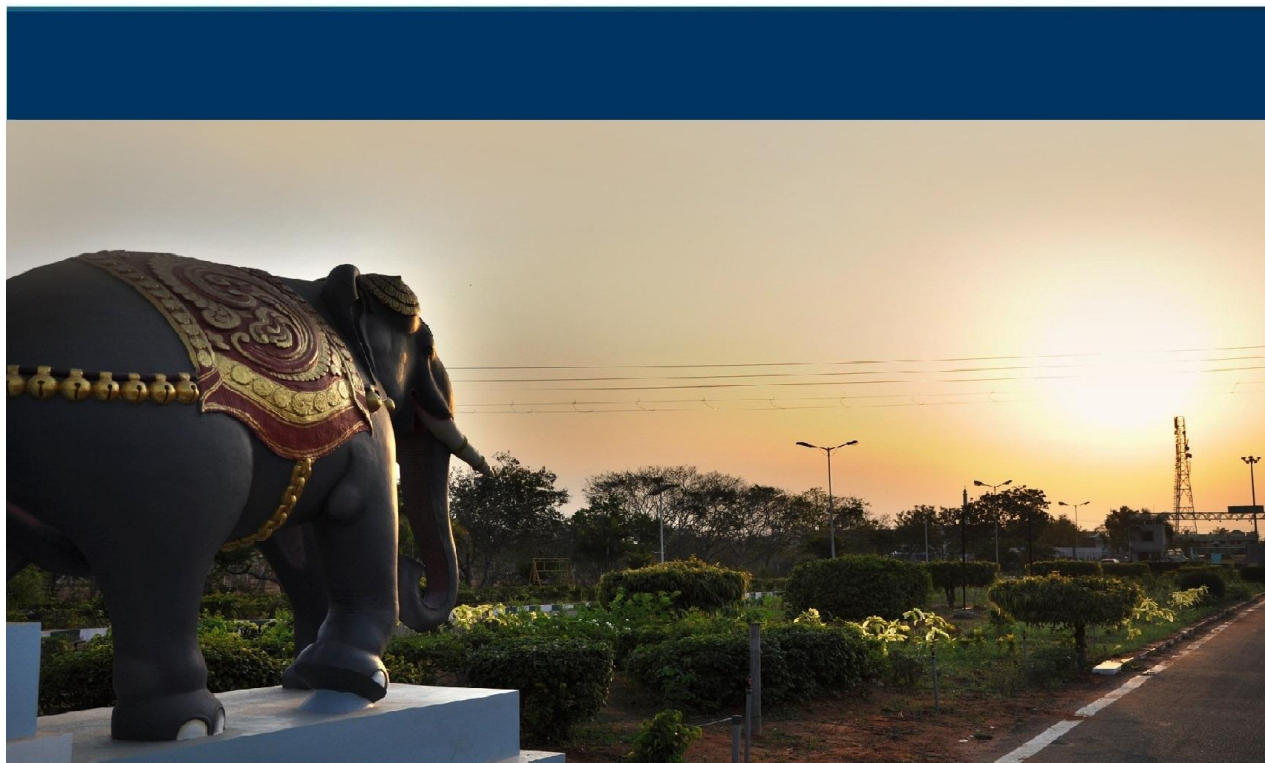
