- ❖ Increase your knowledge on all subjects you are required to speak.
- ❖ Speak clearly and audibly.
- ❖ Clarify Key Points.
- ❖ Use chalkboard and Suitable A.V teaching aids.
- ❖ While listening, always make notes of important points.
- ❖ Always clarify doubts.
- ❖ Be Punctual and Keep time.

# CLASSROOM TEACHING

## Don'ts

- ❖ Do not look bored and dull.
- ❖ Do not read from your notes or dictate.
- ❖ Do not try to cover everything.
- ❖ Do not use technical terms & terminologies not understood by majority of students.
- ❖ Do not speak too fast or too slow.
- ❖ Do not face away from your students.
- ❖ Do not speak in inaudible surroundings.
- ❖ Do not interrupt the speaker.
- ❖ Do not jump to the conclusion directly.
